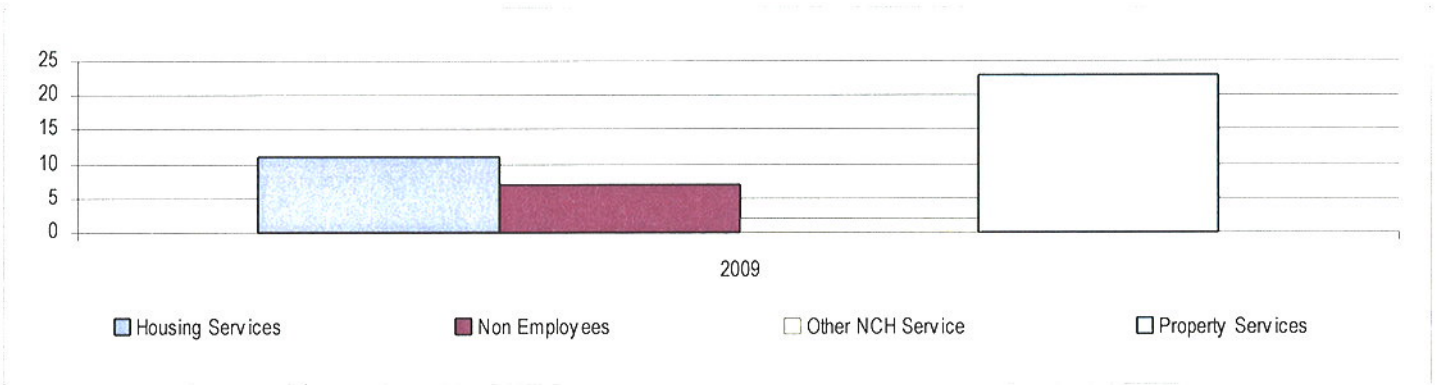

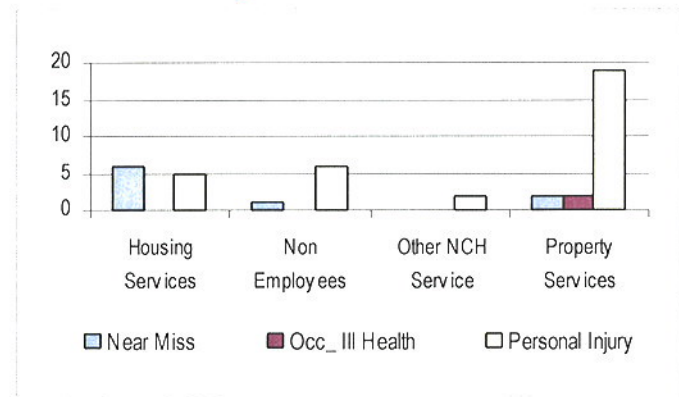

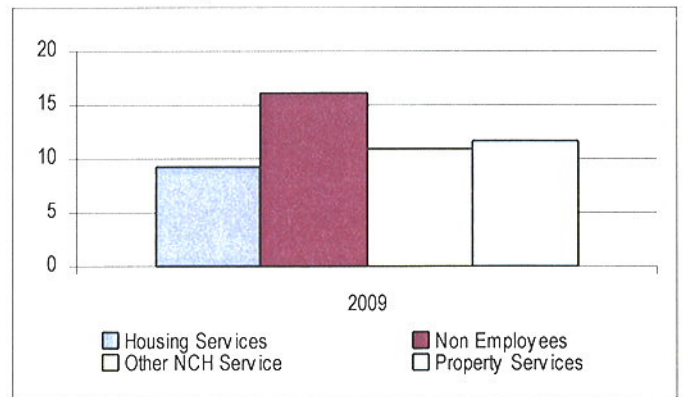
*Number of incidents in each service*



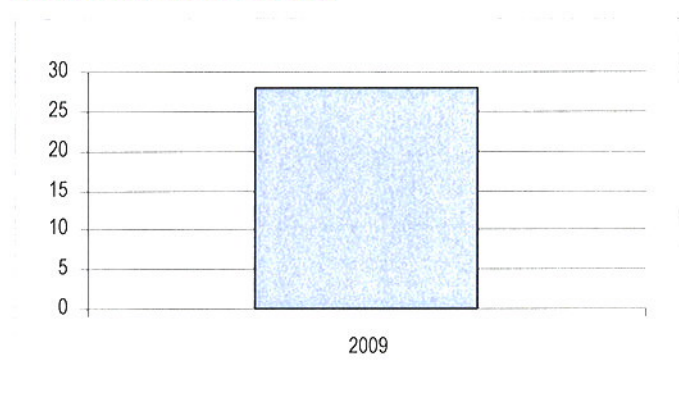
*Types of incident (i.e. near miss, personal injury, disease or observed hazard)*



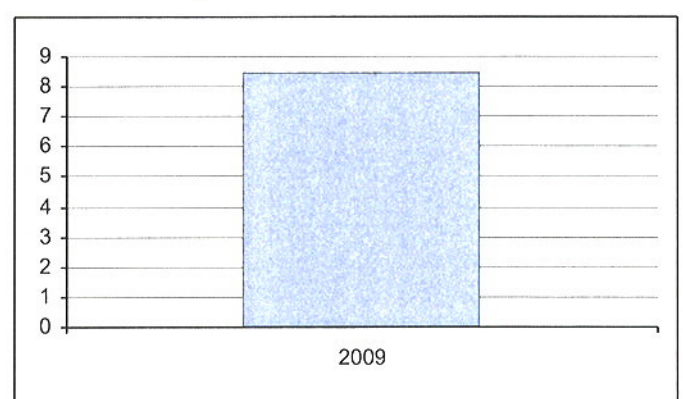
*Average number of days taken to report incidents to NCH Health and Safety service*



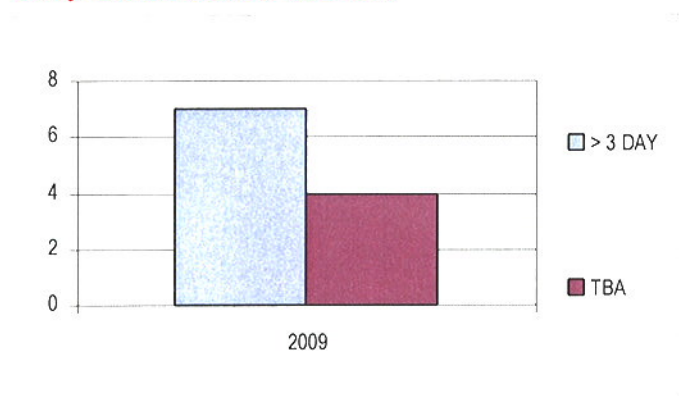
*Proportion of incidents investigated by NCH Health and Safety service (percentage)*



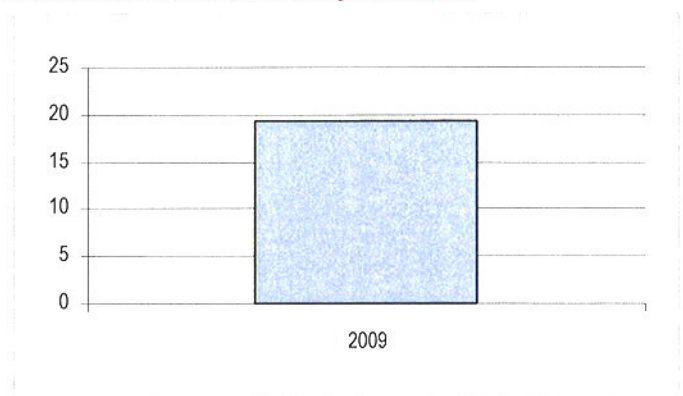
*Average number of days taken by NCH Health and Safety service to investigate incidents*
