ASSET MANAGEMENT RISK REGISTER (HIGH LEVEL)

1 SUMMARY

- 1.1 NCH manages 29,000 properties on behalf of Nottingham City Council and is responsible for the Health and Safety implications which arise from that responsibility. This document sets out for members of the Property Services Committee some of the Asset Risks and shows the processes of mitigation which the company currently uses help to minimise this risk.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

- 2.1 It is recommended that the Property Services Committee notes the contents of the report.

3 REPORT

- 3.1 The purpose of this report is to stimulate understanding of the asset risks for members of the Property Services Committee and to enable challenge and debate on the issues highlighted.
